Dear Dr. McCallin,

Thank you for joining the WGU Community College Partnership Program. This agreement is between WGU and the State of Colorado, Department of Higher Education, State Board for Community Colleges and Occupational Education, for the use and benefit of the Colorado Community College System (CCCS).

Our mission is to expand access to affordable, high quality bachelor's degrees for your graduates who cannot easily attend a campus-based program.

Under the terms of this agreement CCCS will:

1. Maintain a [link](http://www.wgu.edu/transferstudent) to the WGU landing page for CCCS graduates. The URL for this webpage is: <http://www.wgu.edu/transferstudent>.
2. CCCS will include information about WGU degree programs, as appropriate, whenever written communications about transfer options are sent to prospective graduates and transfer students.
3. Maintain current print material about WGU degree programs in your Academic Advising offices. All print material will be provided by WGU at no cost.

In return, WGU will:

1. Offer a 5% tuition discount for the first year (two terms) of a student's degree program.
2. Encourage your graduates who enroll at WGU to apply for the WGU Community College Partner Scholarship and other available scholarships. Scholarships may be used in addition to the tuition discount. Selection criteria include: academic records,

readiness for online study, financial need, and other considerations. Information about WGU scholarships can be found at <http://www.wgu.edu/scholarships>.

3. The benefits of this agreement extend to faculty and staff of CCCS.


4. Provide, as attachments to this document, transfer credit reviews for AAS, AA and AS degree graduates in the areas of education, nursing, business and IT offered at CCCS. Reviews will show the number of transferable credits to WGU and the number of competency units (CUs) required to graduate from selected WGU bachelor degree programs.

In order to help educate your transfer counselors and faculty, WGU will conduct webinars and/or come to your campus to inform them about our degree programs and student services.


This agreement can be cancelled by either party with 30 days notice. The benefits of the agreement shall extend to students within CCCS enrolled at WGU for the duration of their continuous enrollment.
